




# Hamrah Aval Project

One of the most exciting challenges of this project was the application of the employer's organizational identity based on the principles set out in the Hamrah e Aval brand book, in the design of the overall idea and products used. The key elements of this project were to create dedicated workspaces for a large number of people, to create spaces for meetings, to allow managers and supervisors to be present in the same space but in separate sections, and to facilitate the movement and access of all staff to coworking spaces. Another part of the project was a conference room for formal face-to-face and online meetings. It was also anticipated that one of the types of meetings that would be held in this space would require a separate space for meeting moderators, and would certainly be part of the sessions to discuss topics that would require special audio-visual facilities. In addition to these requests of the employer, in the design and production of furniture, we had to use organizational colors in various parts of interior design. Finally, the implemented project became one of the most attractive works of Paadiran in the last few years.



# Fadak Trains Project

In the project of designing and producing office furniture for the office building of Fadak Trains Company, we faced several challenges:

First, an important part of the interior design of the building in this project had already been implemented and in the middle of the road had undergone changes that may have affected the nature of the design of office products and furniture.


For example, we used MDF with natural wood veneer on some tables and part of the wall coverings, so that we could bring together the inherently contrasting elements of the design.

In parts of this project, by using colored glass in the partition, which was one of the colors seen in the floor stone, while making changes in the beauty of the environment, we provide covered spaces that were requested by the employer.

The second challenge was that the furniture designed and produced had to match the visual identity of the company, which had previously been designed and implemented by other teams.

The third challenge was project scheduling, which had to be completed in a limited and fast time frame.

Finally, the project of designing and producing office furniture for the central building of Fadak Trains Company was successfully completed in March 2017 by Paadiran Office Interior Decoration Consulting Company.

In the long years of its existence, this collection has always been one of the current-creating parts of Iranian art.




Using bright colors, textures, and patterns similar to wood, using large volumes, avoiding the use of additional lines and textures in product design, observing the use of colors derived from nature that retain their charm over the years and the correct and appropriate use of the philosophy of open workspaces were among the principles that were considered in this project.

Working on this project was exciting for us in many ways. Matching the design and color of the desks with the part of the building's interior that was cement and had changed color over the years, but still represented the main spirit and essence of the building design.

In addition to maintaining, the simplicity and practicality of the products were one of the challenges of this project.

Social space is important, so we will want to include more flexible amenities like Town Halls and cafés. These offer a place for meetings large and small, socializing, and company events of all kinds.





# Arman Sabz Adineh Project


Arman Sabz Adineh Company is a large company in the field of preparation and production of agricultural and horticultural inputs and products, which started its activities in 2007.

The construction project of the company's head office on Sheikh Baha'i Street in Tehran was completed in late 1399, and at the same time with the development of the final parts of the building, the interior design and design and production of the office furniture of the company was left entirely to Paadiran Company.

In designing this project, in addition to the previous conditions, due to the employer's time requirement to evacuate the company's scattered offices in several buildings and the integration of all activities of the organization in the new headquarters, time constraints had to be considered.

The central building of Arman Sabz Adineh Group, with 7 floors and an approximate area of 1800 square meters, was one of the projects carried out in 1400 by the Paadiran office interior decoration consulting company. The main challenge of this project was the scope of activities of this holding, each of which had different organizational identities, interests, needs, and necessities, and it was necessary to provide different designs and products for different parts of this organization. At the same time, organizational integrity had to be observed.


Also, the accompaniment of different parts of the organization, which was a combination of shared workspaces, private rooms, public and private spaces, increased the complexities of interior design and design and production of office furniture in this project.



















#### Zarrin Barg Persia Project 2021

Design and production of office furniture for the head office of Zarrin Barg Persia Manufacturing Company, one of the largest factories producing tissue and sanitary textiles in Iran, located in Bokharest st., Tehran was Another project implemented by Paadiran Company in 1400.

In this project, according to the client's work style, modern and at the same time confidential spaces with two different styles of office furniture were used. We used double-glazed aluminum partitions with colored frames and glass covered with stickers, which created a modern look & provided the custom spaces desired by the client.

We also used neoclassical furniture with a luxurious design structure in parts of this project and modern and simple furniture in other parts. Also, due to the closed of most workspaces, light design was very important and while providing the necessary amount of light for each environment, it had to follow a modern appearance and fit the overall structure of the project.



## Sepahan Battery Project 2021


Design and production of office furniture for the head office of Sepahan Battery Industrial Company is another project carried out by Paadiran Company in 1400.


In this project, there is a building that uses elements such as a brick facade and large windows in the architecture of the building. The predominance of light gray in the interior also formed another part of the building's identity. In the first step, the needs of the employer were assessed based on the divisions of the work space and the way of workflow and personnel.

Also, due to the large windows and the visibility of parts of the brick facade of the building, we were convinced that we should use colored families similar to the facade of the building in the color of the office furniture, in order to create more harmony. The use of large windows has resulted in very good natural light in all parts of the building, and so we use the natural light in the interior divisions to create more harmony with the large glass windows of the building. We used glass dividers between people in workstations and partitions used in different sections.



Design and production of office of Qali Soleiman Manufacturing Company was another project implemented by Padayran Company in 1400. In this project, we faced several challenges. First, the products of this company, which are carpets and rugs, mainly follow the frameworks and standards of traditional Iranian art, which creates a strong mentality for the audience.


So in the first step we had to determine whether we should follow this visual identity or not. Based on intensive and long-distance negotiations with the employer, the decision was to follow the visual identity of the central building of modern principles and independent of the mental identity of the company's products, because it has a modern and leading work structure among its other competitors despite being one of the most successful companies in the field of production which is taken from traditional Iranian arts.

In the second step, we had to decide on how to divide the workspaces and to what extent these spaces are formal and informal, private and communal, open plan and closed rooms.

Based on the initial history that was compiled, we decided to use neutral colors, aluminum partitions with large partitions and glass with shutters for the possibility of using open or closed workspaces, tables with glass bases or Low-volume metal to reduce the visual volume of these items and the use of MDF with stone and cement coatings to enhance the modern feeling, were among the details that we considered in the implementation of this project.



Design and production of office furniture The project of Tis Choob central office in Tehran is one of the completed projects in 1400 of Paadiran company.

The main activity of this company is the preparation and production of various types of chipboard and MDF sheets, MDF coated sheets, MDF sheets with melamine and glass coatings and other related items in different dimensions and sizes and used in Is the furniture industry.

In this project, we had to follow some important principles: First, we had to choose furniture that has a high design flexibility and can simultaneously, taking into account the functional requirements and maintaining the same style in design in all tables, including the executive desk, conference desk, manager desk and workstation.


With the choice of the Fara table family, this challenge ended well. All tables used in this project are from the same family and while maintaining the integrity of the design, they also have different uses.

In the next step, due to the employer's desire to use color in the interior design of the workplace, we had to use single-glazed partitions in which colored glass or profiles could be used.

At the same time, we had to be careful so that the minimal atmosphere of the company's interior design was not disturbed and all sections of office furniture followed the same principles.

The selection of office chairs and sofas was the last and important part of this project, which had to follow all the previous principles and at the same time provide ease of use for different uses.





In this project, one of the main elements that had to be observed in all different parts of the project and in all the details of the office furniture used, was the main and dominant color in the project.


Due to the main nature of the employer's job, which is activity in the financial field, in all work sections of this project, archive cabinets, filing cabinets, libraries and wall cabinets should have been used in large volumes. Also, this part of office furniture should be designed and produced in a way that does not occupy a large visual volume and at the same time has a high degree of flexibility.

The geographical location of this office, which is located on one of the upper floors of an office tower in the north of Tehran, provided the opportunity to make the most of the natural design and attractive land-scapes in the interior design.


As a result, the use of glass partitions with large slats is one of the design principles of this project. To create more harmony, all the profiles of aluminum partitions used in this project were painted in Paadiran factory with electrostatic coating.


Another feature of this project is the use of cupboards that are installed next to the windows and by installing a seating area, they have become flexible furniture for holding short working meetings and using environmental capabilities.



In this project, which was implemented in 6 floors of 400 square meters and a total of 2400 square meters, a department with specified organizational tasks has been established on each floor.

Management, internal and external trade, after-sales, technical, IT and executive departments are located on the same floor.


Even though each class has a separate organizational division from other classes and naturally they should use office furniture designed based on the work style and related job description, at the same time, they should use the same approach in the DNA of designing office furniture and partition products. We used glass.


Observing these two principle at the same time has made it possible to make changes in the design of office furniture and partitions on each floor, while observing the functional characteristics of these products, the identity of the customer's brand is also respected and we do not face different designs when walking on different floors. The use of the dominant color theme of gray, the use of aluminum and glass, and the minimal and simple design of office furniture helped us to meet the demands of the client.

The precise and flexible design of Paadiran glass partitions made it possible for us to simultaneously use colored glass in one part, shutters in another part, and large and transparent glass in other parts for the different demands of the client to embed.







The frame of all the single-wall and double-wall partitions, with different heights and different features, were all painted black with electrostatic powder paint so that, while creating distinction, the vertical and horizontal lines they make are in line with the interior design details of the building. In different parts of this building and at the same time, there are different departments such as management, formal and informal meeting rooms, co-working rooms, silence rooms and reception counters, which, while respecting the integrity of the design, should have appropriate functional and appearance characteristics.

Also, without occupying a large amount of work space, we should have installed a lot of closets and files for the employees.

We had the honor of long-term cooperation and friendship with another large and well-established company in Iran in this project, and Tabriz Tile Industrial Group was added to the group of friends of Paadiran.




















# Reyhaneh Gostar Afarinesh Project 2021

For work spaces, we used products from the Merta family, namely Merta bachelor desks and Merta group work desks. Long single-wall partition with sticker in some places covered by customer's request and painted aluminum frame, light cream colors of base and table cover, high quality office flooring, ergonomic chairs suitable for long-term sitting, installation of bags for all users. Using cable trays to hide wires and cables from sight, installing access points in the workplace to use electricity and network equipment, etc. are all coordinates of office furniture and interior decoration in the working spaces of this collection. . The conference rooms are equipped with two different styles of conference tables. Conference table with white color, thick plate and separator plate for more coverage and installation of larger electrical accesses for more use of relevant facilities for holding official meetings and table with black plate and smaller dimensions and removing electricity. has access At work to hold meetings with less formality. In the public spaces and lobbies of this project, in order to create more intimacy and empathy with the audience, counters with a large glass part painted in blue color, a large built-in buffet with the purpose of placing awards and certificates have been installed. Decorative vases are the main elements of this design. Also, in all the different parts of this project, built-in lights or linear lights that are designed for proper exposure to all these spaces have been used.








#### Counter

# Maadiran Project 2021

The design, production and furnishing of the office furniture of Madiran household appliance factory was done by Paadiran in 1400.

In fact, this building is a part of the general atmosphere of the factory, which is located in Payam Free Zone.

Large spaces with high sloping and exposed ceilings, simple columns, large and glass facade, gray color theme that was used on the floor and most of the walls and columns created the atmosphere of an industrial environment.

Therefore, it was necessary for the office furniture and partitions to be in harmony with this atmosphere and the ceiling. Using the family of grid tables that have an industrial style was a smart choice by the designer of the collection.

This family of products, with simple bases, cubic structure and simplicity in form, are completely compatible with industrial environments. In addition, it has a wide variety of products and has management desks, group work desks, desks, buffets, libraries, files and closets with the same concept, and they are among the relatively economical category of Paadiran office furniture products.








#### Single-Glazed Partition







The public is more familiar with bad design than good design. It is, in effect, conditioned to prefer bad design, because that is what it lives with. The new becomes threatening, the old reassuring.









# Karafarin Bank Project 2021









