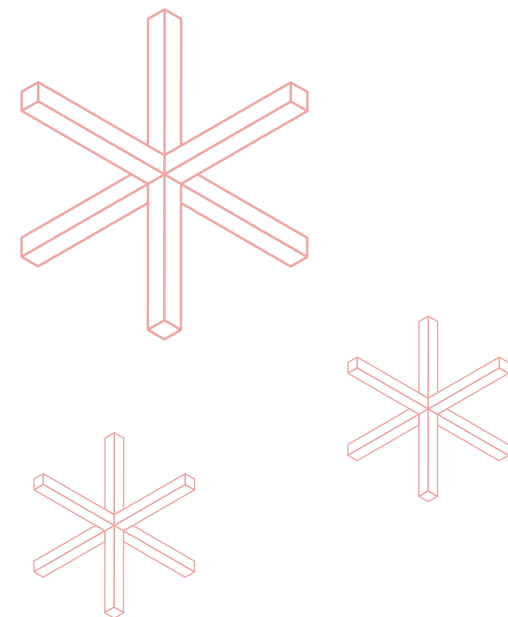
The design of the seating structure of users in these desks is such that by maintaining distance and having a dedicated workspace, they can interact and participate in the work.
